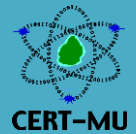

Multiple Vulnerabilities in Microsoft Products

Original Issue Date: July 08, 2014

Severity Rating: High

Description:

Multiple vulnerabilities have been identified in Microsoft products and they can be exploited by remote attackers to gain knowledge of sensitive information, elevation of privileges and bypass security restrictions. The vulnerabilities are as follows:

Remote Code Execution	Critical	Internet Explorer on all supported editions of Windows.	Requires restart
Remote Code Execution	Critical	Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008, Windows 7, Windows Server 2008 R2, Windows 8, Windows 8.1, Windows Server 2012, Windows Server 2012 R2, Windows RT, and Windows RT 8.1.	May require restart
Elevation of Privilege	Important	All supported editions of Windows, except Windows Server 2003.	Requires restart
Elevation of Privilege	Important	All supported editions of Windows.	Requires restart
Elevation of Privilege	Important	Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008, Windows 7, Windows Server 2008 R2, Windows 8, Windows 8.1, Windows Server 2012, and Windows Server 2012 R2.	May require restart

Denial of Service	Moderate	Windows Server 2008 R2, Windows Server 2012, and Windows Server 2012 R2.	Does not require restart
