Google Cloud and Cloudflare hit by widespread service outages

Description

Multiple popular online services were hit by outages in the late afternoon of Thursday 12 June 2025, including Spotify, Discord, Google and Amazon Web Services. The outage came as service providers Cloudflare and Google Cloud experienced service disruptions. As per Cloudflare, various services were having intermittent failures. The company also stated that they are investigating on this issue and will update the list of affected services as they assess the impact on a per-service level. Currently, the list of impacted Cloudflare services includes:

- Access
- WARP
- Durable Objects (SQLite-backed Durable Objects only)
- Workers KV
- Realtime
- Workers AI
- Stream
- Waiting Room
- Parts of the Cloudflare dashboard
- AI Gateway
- AutoRAG

Google Cloud also published an incident report regarding an issue affecting multiple Google Cloud Platform services, including Bigtable, Console, Dataproc, Storage, Cloud Data Fusion, Cloud Memorystore, Cloud Shell, Cloud Workstations, Identity Platform, Memorystore for Memcached, Memorystore for Redis, Memorystore for Redis Cluster, Vertex AI Search, and Identity and Access Management.

Google stated that they are investigating on the issue and was working on implementing a fix. Some services, however, appeared to be restored. Although ongoing outages continue.
