CERT-MU Security Alert

Scam Alert: Fake Speeding Fines in Mauritius

Severity Level: High

Description:

CERT-MU wishes to alert the public to a fixed penalty scam in circulation via SMS with the subject line: *"Traffic Enforcement Alert – Speeding Case"*. The scam in circulation is sent to a vehicle owner in Mauritius, stating that he/she has exceeded the speed limit and is liable to a fine as per the Road Traffic Act. Consequently, the recipient has to pay a fine of Rs. 2,500 within 1 day by clicking on the link in the message:

<https://govmu-avip.cam/mus>

In the event of non-payment, legal proceedings will be initiated against the recipient, and the driving license will be suspended.

CERT-MU advises the public to be vigilant against this scam. The following measures are recommended:

- Do not click on the link
- Do not share any personal or banking information.
- Official government portals in Mauritius use the **.govmu.org** domain - always verify the URL closely.
- Report the incident to CERT-MU if you have encountered such a message.
- Contact your bank immediately if you have made a payment.
